Who are the characters in this chapter?

Where did this chapter take place?

Comprehension

What is the main idea of the chapter?

Can you explain what is happening in the chapter?

Can you summarize the chapter?

Application

What would you change in the chapter if you could?

What questions would you ask if interviewing the main character after this chapter?

Analysis

What is the theme...

Why do you think...

Synthesis

What would a scene look like through another characters eyes?

Rewrite this scene with another narrator?

How might a different character address a problem?

Evaluation

Why did they (the character) choose...?

How would you defend (the characters) actions?

Do you agree with the actions...

Types of reflection you could make

Things to track and think about

- **Character**
 - How have they changed?
 - What insights have they gained?

What are the big ideas?

- What conflict(s) have arisen?
- What do these conflicts tell the reader?
- What claims does the author make?

What is your favourite passage? Why?

What have you read that created a response?

Track confusion

- What is confusing? Have you figured it out yet?
- Show evidence of trying to solve the confusion.

Thought Starters

- I noticed...
- I wonder...
- I was reminded of...
- I'm surprised that...
- The central issue(s) are...
- One consequence of _____ could be...
- I'm not sure...

"That" statements

- This passage makes me think that...
- This makes me feel that...
- The author is suggesting that...

Response Qs

What surprised you?

How did it make you feel? Why?

If you were the character what would you do?

Do you agree with the characters?

What are some big ideas you think you are noticing? Evidence?

Reflection Q's

What did you notice about this writing?

Why does this writing matter?

What questions do you have now?

How might reading this change you? How could you change the world because of it?
